Candle Wall Holder

Pottery Barn is one of my favorite places to shop and get inspiration from. Though fairly in-expensive, a lot of their items can also be re-created at home. This project is inspired by an item they sell, but if you have the time, make it yourself for less than half the price!

Materials:

Metal curtain rod and holding brackets
24 gauge wire
Pliers
Glass votives
Tea lights

Total Time: 1 Hour

Total Cost: About \$30 or less

Directions:

Attach the curtain rod onto the wall where you wish to hang the candles. Remember to measure the length of the wall before you buy the rod. Once a rod is up and secure, decide on the number of candle hangers you want and their lengths. Cut the wire for each of the hangers, allowing an extra ten inches for wrapping around the votive. Wrap each piece of wire around a glass votive tightly. Twist the extra wire end and wrap it around the curtain rod. Trim if needed. Repeat with each candle hanger. Insert the tea lights into the votive holde
